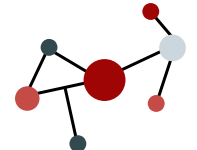

We conduct ethics review for research that includes humans as participants. This includes biomedical research and social and behavioral sciences research.

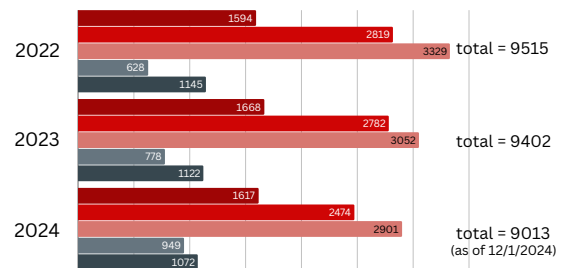
### MISSION
